

A discussion was held on Thursday, September 11 about issues that have been raised concerning Article 6 of the Bylaws of the Club (v2007) which currently read:

Article 6 Fees and Dues

Section 1 – The admission fee shall be \$50 to be paid before the applicant can qualify as a member, except as provided for in the standard Rotary club constitution, article 11.

Section 2 – The membership dues shall be set by the following formula, payable quarterly, with the understanding that a portion of each semiannual payment shall be applied to each member's subscription to the RI official magazine. The formula for quarterly membership dues is one-fourth of the Rotary International dues, plus one-fourth of the District 7690 dues, plus weekly cost of meals times 13 weeks.

It was noted that it has been years since the club has collected an admission fee of \$50.

It was recommended that members be billed for anticipated expenditures during the next quarter year not for the previous quarter.

It was recommended that Section 2 be revised as follows:

Section 2 – The membership dues shall be set by the following formula, payable quarterly, with the understanding that a portion of each semiannual payment shall be applied to each member's subscription to the RI official magazine. The formula for quarterly membership dues includes one-fourth of the Rotary International dues, one-fourth of the District 7690 dues, **club dues to be set by the board of directors of the club and meal cost times actual number of meetings held.**

Section 3 - A \$25 late fee will be charged against any bill not paid after each 90 day period.
